



General FAQs.

If my family or I need financial support, how do I apply to PFAP?

Patients can self-refer or request a referral to Cancer Care Alberta (CCA) Social Work. Referral information is available on the [Social Work for Patients and Families](#). Patients aren't applying to PFAP directly at this time; they work with Social Work to determine their financial needs and eligibility for financial resources including government and private supports. PFAP is included as a possible support if patients meet the PFAP Terms of Reference's requirements.

Who can I contact to get more information on PFAP?

How do I know if my family or I are eligible for funding?

Cancer Care Alberta Social Work will work with you and your family and/or support persons to determine your eligibility for PFAP.

To be eligible for PFAP, you need to:

- Have an active Alberta Health Care Number
- Be an adult Alberta resident
- Be receiving cancer treatment at one of the 17 Cancer Care Alberta sites
- Qualify financially as detailed in the PFAP Terms of Reference
